WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?

This course is suitable for those persons required to perform work in confined spaces as well as covering the basic requirements for stand-by personnel and those authorising work permits.

ASSESSMENT METHODS

Students will be assessed in a simulated practical scenario involving confined space entry. Underpinning knowledge will be assessed with a theory assessment (containing multiple-choice questions).

The course content will be delivered in a classroom environment using PowerPoint presentations, videos, group discussions and a number of demonstration and skill building activities.
