WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?

This course is suitable for any person required to perform work at heights.

- Suspension trauma
- Rescue techniques
- Simulated practice scenarios

ASSESSMENT METHODS

Students will be assessed in a simulated practical scenario involving work at heights. Underpinning knowledge will be assessed with a theory assessment (containing multiple-choice questions).

DELIVERY METHODS

The course content will be delivered in a classroom environment using PowerPoint presentations, videos, group discussions and a number of demonstration and skill building activities.
