This course provides participants with the knowledge and skills to provide CPR and use an AED prior to the arrival of medical or other assistance. The content and practical scenarios covered in this course conform with Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines.

Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)

WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?

The primary benefit of this course is to establish properly trained persons who can safely and efficiently perform First Aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation on at risk victims and operate an AED in times of medical emergency. In line with Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines.

COURSE CONTENT

- Recognise an emergency situation
- Identify and assess immediate hazards to health and safety of self and others and minimise these dangers
- Assess the casualty and recognise the need for CPR
- Seek assistance from emergency response services
- Follow Basic Life Support steps (DRSABCD) in treating an unconscious, not breathing casualty
- Perform CPR on an adult and infant manikin in accordance with ARC guidelines
- Operation of First Aid equipment AED unit in accordance with instructions
- Apply safe hygiene and manual handling techniques
- Monitor the casualty's condition and respond accordingly with First Aid principles

COST

\$85 per person excluding GST (if applicable).

ASSESSMENT METHODS

Students will be assessed in a simulated practical scenario's involving performing CPR on an adult and infant manikin in accordance with ARC guidelines and using an AED. Underpinning knowledge will be assessed with a theory assessment (containing multiple-choice questions).

DELIVERY METHODS

The course content will be delivered in a classroom environment using PowerPoint presentations, videos, group discussions and a number of demonstration and skill building activities.

Students must be physically capable of participating in the practical activities and demonstrate a basic level of language, literacy and numeracy.
